

H O N O U R E N T I T L I N G O R D E R

of the International Public Sports Association (IVV)

in the proposed revision of December 01, 2009

1. Honours

- a) Letter of appreciation of President
- b) IVV – Pin of Merit with Certificate
Bronze for 8 years at a minimum
Silver for 15 years at a minimum
Gold for 25 years at a minimum
- c) IVV-Pin of Honour
- d) Appointment to IVV - Honorary President

2. Donees

- a) Functionary of IVV - Congress of Delegates
- b) Functionary and staff of national member associations
- c) Persons, who render outstanding services to IVV-national sport

3. Qualification

- a) Long-time function at IVV
- b) Long-time function at national member associations
- c) Great merits for IVV-national sport

4. Right of Proposal

- a) IVV - Presidium
- b) IVV - Congress of Delegates
- c) National Member Associations

5. Method of Application

For application for honours according 1b) and 1c) IVV forms have to be used and sent to the IVV-Headoffice.

Honours according 1b) start always at lowest level.

6. Honorary President 1d)

1. IVV - Presidents, who render outstanding services to IVV by excellent effort can be appointed after resignation to a Honorary President.
2. The appointment results from proposal of IVV Presidium by decision of IVV-Congress of Delegates.
3. The Honorary President receives a Certificate of Appointment.
4. The Honorary President is entitled to participate at the IVV-Congress of Delegates.

7. Carrying out

The honour is carried out in dignified manner either by a IVV presidium member or a member of a national member association at the IVV-Congress of Delegates or at a Congress of Delegates of a national member association.

8. Disallowing

1. Honours can be recalled by the Presidium at 1b and 1c, by the Congress of Delegates at 1d, if the bearer is guilty of heavy offence against IVV statutes and orders or if legally effective excluded of the association.
2. Association honour awards and certificates have to be returned after recall.

9. Final Clause

1. The IVV - Congress of Delegates is authorized in special exceptional cases to determine and carry out the conferment of an award deviant the existing Honour Entitling Order.
