Security provisions to protect users and the discussion forum itself from receiving or distributing spam will be set as high as possible.

- 5. The IVV Presidium will meet on March 6 & 7 in Val Gardena / Wolkenstein, South Tyrol.
- 6. Introducing Chengdu, China, site of the IVV 2015 Olympiad Chengdu has been named 'China's Best Tourism City' by the United Nations World Tourism Organisation. It is also a centre for science and technology, trade, finance, and transport and communication. Within a 200 km radius, there are six World Heritage Sites for nature and culture. The Giant Panda Habitat is one of the best known natural Heritage Sites. For tourists, there are over 3,000 commercial hotels, including over 100,000 rooms and 170,000 beds. Approximately 20% of the rooms and beds are at the High and Luxurious level.

- 9. The date for the second '<u>Europiade</u>' has been set for June 20 22, 2014 in <u>Marostica, Italy</u> / <u>Naturns, South Tyrol</u>.
